

# **Indiana Strategic Sites Initiative Speed is New Incentive**

- ▶ Deals used to take 18-24 months to be approved; now decisions are made in less than 6 months.
- ► High-wage, high-growth companies looking for sites that are ready for construction.
- ➤ State has lost over \$20 billion of development as other states have implemented this strategy already (Ohio, Michigan, Tennessee, North Carolina, Texas, Georgia, etc.)
- Local officials will retain influence over land use related decisions regardless of the state's ownership or strategy.






### **Benefits of State Involvement**



- Long-term water solutions
  - Area will have limited water resources in the next 10-20 years regardless of additional development
  - State resources can be utilized to provide a long-term, reliable solution for the area to increase development and serve residents at a cost-effective rate.
- Road infrastructure improvement
  - I-65 and CR 300 Interchange
  - State Route Improvements (52, 32, 39, etc.)
  - County roads to improve traffic flow



### Q1 2023



- Anticipate decisions by multiple companies
  - In the microelectronics and electric vehicle sectors
  - These represent significant investment in the multiple tens of billions of dollars
- PUD
  - City, County and IEDC will use the plan development in the drafting and development of the PUD for the long-term governance and land use
- Water/Wastewater
  - Phase 1 implementation likely to begin
