DEFINING A COMMUNITY PLAN

A community plan is a strategic framework that outlines the vision, goals, and actions for shaping a community's growth and development over a set period.

Community Plans

- Neighborhood or district focus
- Addresses localized issues
- Specific topics
 - Public Health
 - Housing
 - Economic Development
- Time horizon (3-5 years)
- No formal regulatory authority
- Supports goals of comprehensive plan

Comprehensive Plans

- Encompasses entire city/county
- Overarching goals/objectives
- High-level framework for growth
- Topics include
 - Transportation
 - Environment
 - Public Facilities
- Time horizon (20-30 years)
- Statutory authority/public policy




